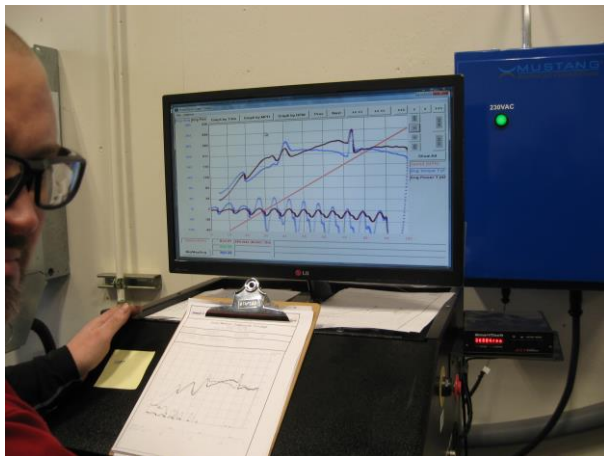


A big Rollin' Oldies thanks to Dan Miner for arranging a tour of the Linn Benton
